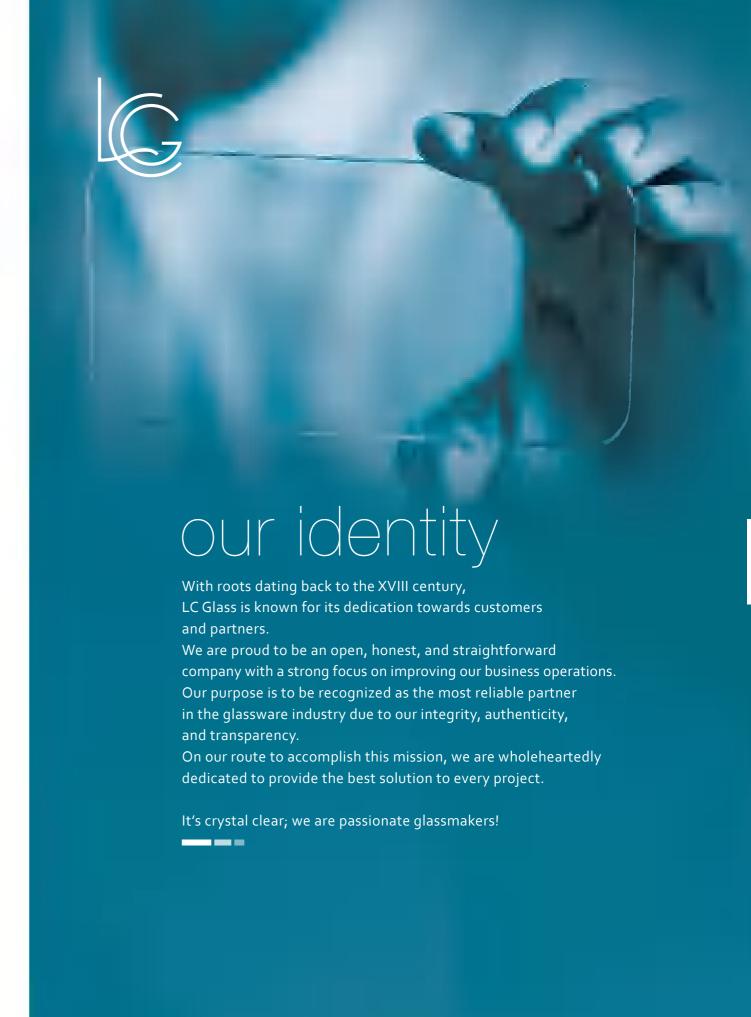

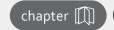

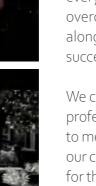

AnDer - the best glass for brewers and beer lovers!



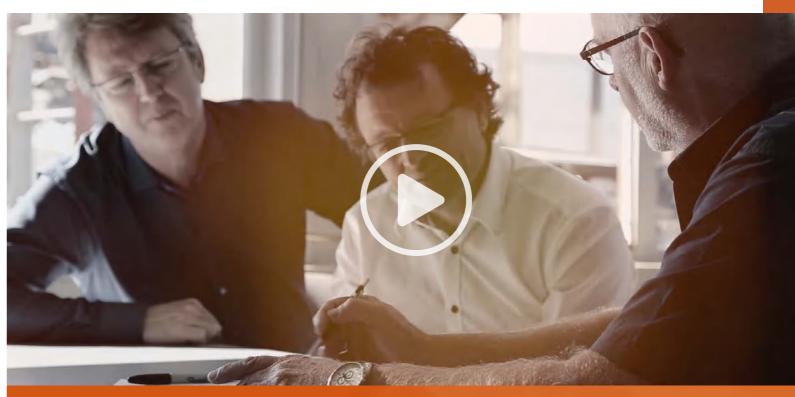
AnDer is a co-creation between Royal Leerdam and Dutch beer experts to develop the ideal glass to smell, taste, evaluate and drink beer.

Ander's beautiful design goes hand-in-hand with its functionality. The wide tulip-shaped bowl, with a narrow top, makes it ideal to optimally judge the flavour, aroma, colour, clarity and foam concentration of different beer styles.

The huge success of this collaboration has encouraged us to develop two additional shapes, perfect for savouring craft beers. This bigger capacity is available in its original short stem and also in a tall stem version for a more dramatic statement.

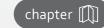

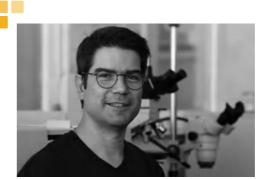

CONVENIENCE, COMFORT & FUNCTIONALITY

Social habits are unlikely to completely revert to pre-pandemic levels, as most consumers seek for safety, comfort, and convenience.

The convenience trend is not a short-term phenomenon – it is here to stay! Comfort and functionality habits are two of the strongest trends witnessed by the food and beverage industry.

The increasing home consumption poses new challenges for Foodservice and require a new approach to original products and innovative on-trade concepts.



In this convenience scenario, the ready-to-drink category continues its meteoric rise. Mainly pushed by hard-seltzers, RTDs are growing more than spirits, wine or beer, and are on track to become the world's most dominant alcohol category. Led by the movement towards RTDs and takeaway cocktails, venues are also incorporating them in cocktails.



Coffee is not just coffee anymore! It's a discovery of new flavours and original mixes, leading to revised rituals and taste preferences in a perfect match to trendy lifestyles. Seductive and stylish, yet technical, the science of coffee injects a new dimension on how it is served in cafés, at home or even at the office.



These days, lack of storage space is a harsh reality both in bars and restaurants, but also at home. To solve this recurrent issue, our glassware collection includes a variety of pressed tumbler ranges specially designed for stacking purposes. Space-saving stackable glassware not only assures a longer service life, but also reduces replacement costs.





HEALTH, WELLNESS & SUSTAINABILITY

Sustainability isn't just about the sake of the planet; it's also about the welfare of people. From the air we breathe to the food and drink we consume, the environment impacts human health.

Consumers are becoming more environmentally conscious and feel a deep need to reconnect with nature. This group seeks to consume foods with benefits that provide them a more holistic approach to life.

Well-being is on top of mind, as consumers intend to keep spending more on products that improve their healthiness and mindfulness.



In this landscape, alcohol producers are evermore committed to contribute for a better world and simultaneously to the wellness of its consumers, by developing no-low alcoholic products that comply with this growing necessity. From their side, consumers support meaningful brands and business practices that actively improve the world.



In the drinks industry, there is an increasing demand for single-origin products, to which brands respond by launching inspired varieties and special editions. Spirits with provenance, made from organic and bio ingredients (such as tequila & rum), or created under artisanal production methods (like mezcal & bourbon), are definitely on the rise. Bartenders crave authentic brands with storytelling, which they can relate to and share with their customers.



Conscious bartending encourages the use of fresher ingredients, support local producers, improving its profits and keeping their guests happy. Sustainable cocktails minimize natural resources and conserve energy, even if it is one lime at a time. It is about throwing away less "leftovers" and using the full potential of each ingredient, embracing a zero waste policy

PREMIUMIZATION, EXPERIMENTATION & INNOVATION

Already an alcohol trend prior to the pandemic, premiumization has accelerated during lockdowns, obviously pushed by at-home consumption. Consumers, especially Millennials, are now willing to pay more money for premium segments of alcohol, such as cognac, whisky, or rum.



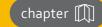
This trend is here to stay and will evolve over the next few years, as consumers seek quality over quantity.

Premiumization will slow down in off-trade retailers, but it's expected to grow dramatically in the on-trade, as consumers are going back to bars and bartenders are incorporating them in cocktails, to elevate the drinking experience.



Rum is growing twice as fast as the spirits category*, mainly pushed by premiumization. Craft Rum is taking the lead, as consumers discover high-quality varieties, while spiced/flavoured rum is recruiting a new generation of drinkers. In a more sustainable approach to the market, Rum producers focus on origin and provenance by using locally grown ingredients and ancient production methods to create organic/artisanal editions.

PREMIUM SPIRITS

Alongside maturity comes sophistication!

Mature segments, such as whisky or cognac are exploring the brave new world of premiumization, while less developed categories like tequila and mezcal invest in experimentation and focus on provenance.



Reinvention is key to conquer new

Category lines are blurring, originating hybrid spirits, both intra-category (fusions between scotch and bourbon or tequila and mezcal) and cross-category (rum aged in bourbon casks, whisky finished in cognac barrels).



Consumers want to expand their world by discovering new blends, new flavours and tastes to thrill their senses. Brands are responding to consumers demands by launching innovative varieties to attract younger drinkers (millennials and Generation Z).

Experimental spirits will emerge, giving rise to endless possibilities for new cocktails and combinations, with intriguing ingredients and mission-driven stories behind them. The emergence of premium spirits has seen consumers spend more money on high-end alcohol brands in the off-trade.

As a consequence, status spirits have grown more than the total spirits market and is expected to accelerate in categories such as Rum, Tequila or American Whisky. Premium-and-above spirits will grow their global volume market share over the next few years, as consumers seek quality over quantity.

CRAFT BEER

While conventional beer consumption is slowly declining worldwide, craft beer is shaking up this pioneer industry, by adopting future trends earlier than any other. Betting on premiumization, innovative varieties, new styles, and original flavours make the difference.

The craft beer boom is pushed by an increasing demand for high-quality beverages with a sustainable footprint.

Brands are creating an exclusive universe of customized items worshiped by beer lovers, especially the younger generations who are eager to be part of this trendy and cool subcultural movement.

Craft brewers are definitely paying more attention to glassware for branding purposes!



HAZY IPAs (NEIPAs)

These unfiltered beers look hazily opaque and are available in an array of nuanced flavours, balancing bitterness with a soft mouthfeel to match to consumers' desire for easy drinking, less bitter, more tropical and juicy flavoured beers.



SOUR & WILD BEERS

Ouickly becoming a favourite style amongst modern beer lovers, thanks to unique refreshing flavours and food pairing versatility. Their flavour complexity is appealing for wine and cocktail drinkers, who like the sweet acidity and tartness.



DESSERT STOUTS

Brewers are creating dessert stouts with lactose and ingredients like vanilla, coffee, or cinnamon. Made to be indulgent, these pastry stouts have higher ABVs. and sweet flavours are perfect

Our Glass Lab offers the possibility to create original exclusive designs, through a multitude of customization techniques. Customers can count on our experienced marketing and design team to come-up with original solutions, that turn into clear branding statements.

We can create a totally new design, make a new combination between bowl and stem, or customize an existing shape by switching part of the mold (bottom, footplate, or plunger).

Custom-made glass design is an important marketing tool to many brands, especially in the drinks industry.

PRODUCTION CAPABILITIES

Our production techniques allow us to develop exclusive bespoke glasses for drinks' brands and other market segments. Features like embossing, feeder-colour or stackabilty, are added values when it comes to customizing existing shapes.

LC Glass currently owns three different production processes, that are ideal for customization purposes. The blown process includes pressed-blown and fix-blown, while pressed has three options (block-mold, split-mold and tulip-mold), and two-piece stemware that combines both processes (blown bowl & pressed stem).

SIDEWALL EMBOSSING

Embossing is the most common way to customize glassware. Brands often create signature glasses by reproducing its logos embossed in the sidewalls of a glass. Available in fixed-blown and pressed techniques, it can be applied in a wide range of items, from tumblers to stemware, mugs or any other shape.



* Fixed-blown embossing





Pressed tumblers or mugs can be customized with a lower investment. By switching only part of the mold (bottom) we can turn a standard shape into an exclusive branded item. Fix-blown items and two-piece stemware can also be branded on the base.



* This is an exclusive item that cannot be used or reproduced for other customers. The picture is being used only as an example of this capability.





FOOTPLATE EMBOSSING

Stemmed glasses can be customized without losing its elegance. A subtle branding embossed on the base of the footplate it is an affordable solution to create a signature stemware.



STEM EMBOSSING

This feature permits to create original designs, by juxtaposing a simple bowl shape with an elaborated stem, that can reproduce detailed elements and patterns, or be sculpted by facets, angles and curves.

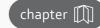

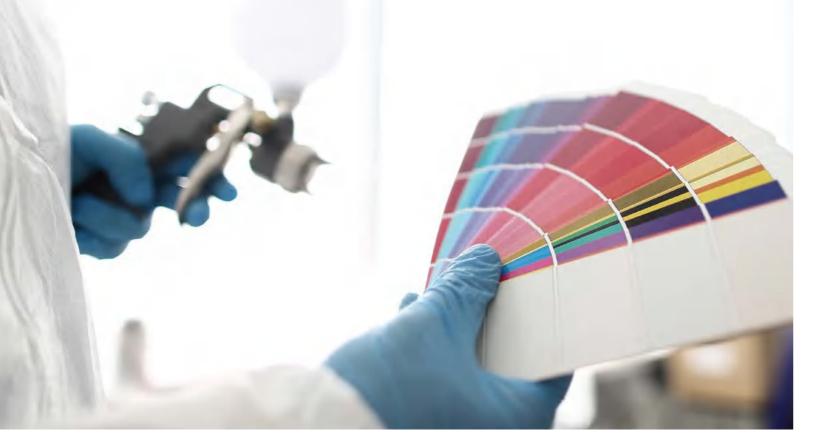

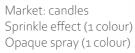

PACKAGING MATERIALS

Corrugated cardboard it's the proper packaging material for packing, storage and shipping glassware. It's a cheaper and sustainable material made from recycled resources, effectively protecting fragile items, and it is easily printable, therefore, ideal for branding and logistical customization. Available in single or double flute it is suitable for boxes and packaging, as the smooth exterior surfaces ensure that it's easily stacked for efficient storage and transportation. Double flute is ideal for heavier items for its strength, which permits larger stacking in warehouses and shipping containers.

PRINTING TECHNIQUES

•• OFFSET

Offset printing is the most commonly used printing technique for paper surfaces. It has the highest printing quality, with remarkable definition in reproducing pictures, allowing a wide variety of finishes, and prints until 6 colours, plus finishes.



FLEXO

Flexography is a printing that can be used for printing almost any type of substrate, including paper, plastic or metal. Flexo has generally low printing quality, with limited colours, no finishes and it's unable to reproduce complicated intricate artworks with very detailed images.



HD FLEXO

A new generation of digital flexo with more printing definition, reproducing high-resolution imaging through high-definition optics. It prints sharper images, text, and other lines, with bigger consistency and higher efficiency, reproducing better dots and delivering better colours with more natural whites and grey levels. It can also create textured surfaces. When compared to offset, it only becomes a cost advantage for big quantities.



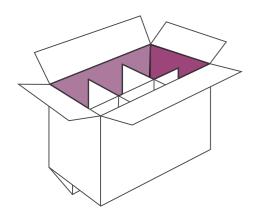




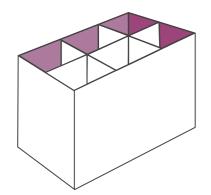

Tumblers often contain a lower chamber that helps to preserve the singularities of each beer, delaying the release of its flavours and aromas, known as the "chimney effect". These strange looking designs are perfect for the complex acidity and tartness of sour and wild beers.

Stemmed glasses feature a wide angled bowl, being most suitable for the indulgent sweetness of dessert stouts or the tropical juicy flavours of Hazy IPAs.

Both designs show an angled profile that influences the beer's carbonation and holds the head foam, while its pronounced lip on the rim makes it easier to savour craft beers.

BELGIAN BEERS

These short stemmed beer glasses are perfect to serve strong Belgian ales and stouts, Flemish red or sour brown ales. Its rounded bowl emphasize the beer flavours while the tapering top captures the aromas, enhancing the tasting experience.

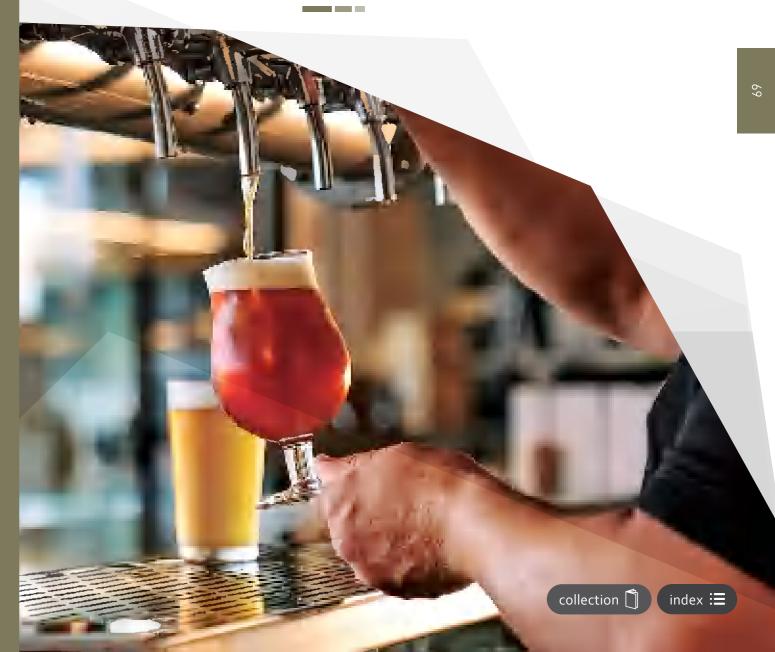

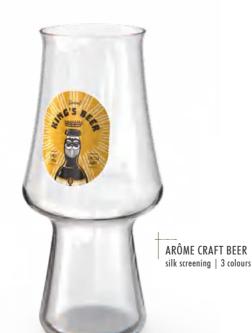

BALLOONS

Brandy glasses are traditionally balloon-shaped, featuring a rounded bowl with a narrow rim on a short stem. However, tulip-shaped bowls are more appropriate to savour a cognac due to its convex design, which directs the aromas to the nose, and the flavours to the back of the palate, capturing the essence of these spirits.

SNIFTERS/TASTERS

Spirits must be tasted in tulip-shaped glasses for a full appreciation of these elixirs in all its splendour.

The slightly closed shape of the glass locks in the aromas, which are then gradually revealed during tasting by directing the drink to the palate.

FORTIFIED WINES

These sugary liqueur wines must be served slightly chilled in a stemmed glass, avoiding the contact of the bowl with the hand to prevent from warming up.

The narrow rim of the glass brings out the complexity of its flavours and aromas. Fortified wines like Port, Madeira, Sherry, Marsala or Muscatel perfectly pair up with desserts, sweets, fruits or even cheeses. These sweet-natured wines long neglected by wine lovers, are now attracting a new generation of wine drinkers.

SPECIALTY LIQUEURS

Glasses with diferent shaped bowls to serve aperitif or digestif liqueurs. While Aquavit or Limoncello are served in a V-shaped short-stemmed glass, Grappa or Amaros are served in a stemware with a long and narrow tulip-shaped bowl.

CORDIALS / LIQUEURS

Cordial glasses are short-stemmed glasses with mall capacities (often tulip shaped), generally used to serve cordials or liqueurs.

SHOTS/SHOOTERS

The difference between shots and shooters is slim, but significant. Shots have been around since the Renaissance period, and consist on a single shot of spirits or liqueurs, while a shooter is a miniature mixed drink (the B-52 or the Kamikaze). You often find shooters in tall and thin glasses, while shots of liquor are served in short and heavier vessels.

ROCKS/DOF

The Double Old-Fashioned (DOF) is the big brother of the Rocks, and therefore also known as a Double Rocks. With its wide rim and often heavy thick base, is ideal for full-bodied alcoholic drinks and cocktails. The rocks, also known as old-fashioned (upon the famous cocktail with the same name), is the classic choice for serving spirits neat or on the rocks.

standard shapes for

spirits & liqueurs

Spirits are alcoholic beverages purified through a distillation process, obtained from fermented cereals, grains, plants or berries (vodka, rum, whisky, tequila, gin, cognac).

Liqueurs are beverages bottled with added sugars, containing flavours usually derived from fruits, herbs or nuts (coffee liqueur, limoncello, maraschino, anis, amaretto, cream liqueur).



spirits & liqueurs



Spirits and liqueurs can be savoured in many ways: straight, on-the-rocks, mixed or simply for a tasting. For each different serve there's an appropriate glass shape.

For a perfect tasting, ideally the glass should have a convex design with a narrow rim to enhance the complexity of flavours and aromas of the drink. To enjoy a spirit on-the-rocks, however, it should be served in a short, wide tumbler that can easily accommodate ice cubes, such as a rocks or double old fashioned glass. If the preference, however, is to enjoy it straight in one sip, shot glasses are the best option.

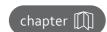

SPARKLING WINES

For more than 300 years, the Coupe was the preferred champagne glass, until it started to be replaced by the tall elegant lines of the Flute, in the early 20th century. Red wines containing fewer tannins, require a large bowl with a wide mouth, allowing the wine to breathe and carefully release its subtle flavours and delicate aromas.

ROUND & MATURE RED WINES

Full bodied red wines with a higher concentration of tannins, result in a bigger complexity of flavours and aromas. These wines ask for a long bowl with a narrow mouth, directing the wine to the back of the palate for a full tasting experience.

RICH & HEAVY WHITE WINES

Full bodied white wines require glasses with wider bowls and a tulip shaped opening, to enhance the complexity of aromas, directing the wine to the back of the tongue to enjoy the intensity of flavours.

LIGHT & FRESH WHITE WINES

Glasses with smaller bowls are perfect for lighter wines with less amount of alcohol. A narrower rim concentrates the delicate and subtle aromas, directing the wine to the tip of the tongue for an easier flavour delight.

DESSERT WINES

These underrated fortified wines are paving its way into fine dining. Ideal to savour at the end of a meal, these typically sweet wines must be served slightly chilled, in a short-stemmed glass with a narrow rim, to bring out the complexity of its flavours and aromas.

CASUAL WINES

These functional and versatile low-stemmed glasses, with its smaller sized bowls, are ideal for casual wine drinking moments. Informal wine drinkers are seduced by the aesthetics of tavern-bistro style goblets, in opposition to purpose driven glass designs.

CLEAN WINES

Clean wines are ideal to savour in light-weighted stemless glasses with a simple design, perfectly matching the pureness of the drink. A new and original way to serve and drink wine!

wines & sparkling

Wine is considered the oldest alcoholic drink in the world, with roots dating back to 6.000 BC, in the Caucasus region.

Large scale production started 2.000 years later in Armenia.

Out of all alcoholic drinks, none has had such an historical impact on mankind. The trade of wine between cultures opened up channels for religious and philosophical ideas to spread across Europe, setting the foundations of western society.

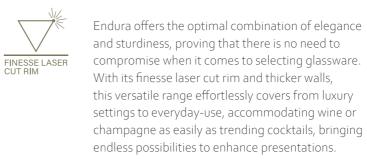

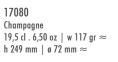

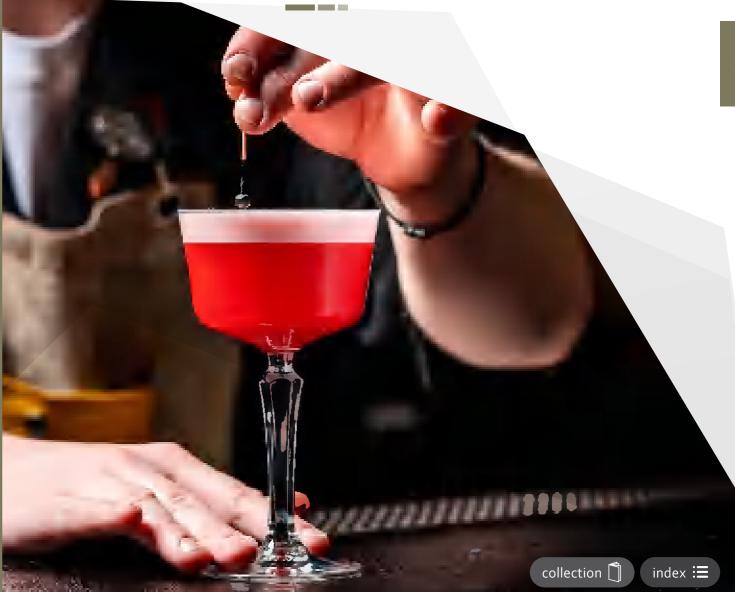

cocktails & barware

Cocktails are alcoholic beverages containing spirits and mixed with ingredients like tonic water, juices, syrups, bitters, spices or cream. Inspired by British punches, cocktails have been around since the beginning of the 19th century but it's only during Prohibition, in the United States, that they become extremely popular. The 1920s are known as the Golden Age of cocktails! However, since the late 1960s cocktails have experienced a continuous decline in popularity, until approximately ten years ago, when the cocktail culture has exploded across Europe and America, through a new style of mixology which combines traditional cocktails with novel ingredients. The resurgence of cocktails has also been boosted by popular TV series like "Mad Men" or "Sex in the City" that have brought back the classic Old Fashioned, the traditional Manhattan or the retro Cosmopolitan.



LARGE BALLOON (COPA)

Gin & Tonic is typically a Highball cocktail, but Copa glasses have been recently paving its way into HB territory. Large balloon stemware can hold more ice for a quicker cooling and its wide bowl allows the aromas to shine, emphasizing the gin's botanicals. The stem keeps the hand away from the bowl, preventing ice to melt and dilute the gin.

MARGARITA

So many classic cocktails are known by the glass they are served in, that we wonder which came first, the glass or the drink. The origins of the Margarita glass are fuzzy and mysterious, but the quirky silhouette of this curvaceous coupe, resembling an inverted Mexican sombrero, is ideal to serve this popular cocktail, as its wide rim cries out for a coating of salt.

MARTINI

If one glass shape captures the glamour of the cocktail age, it's the V-shaped Martini glass with its geometric lines and delicate stem. This is the best example of a glass that is known for the cocktail it holds.

COUPE

The Coupe is ideal for serving drinks that should be served chilled, but not on the rocks, and has largely dethroned the Martini glass as the queen of cocktail glasses. Serving cocktails in Coupes heightens any sweetness, reduces the alcohol sensation and helps blend the individual tastes into a satisfying whole.

NICK & NORA

This glass shape is inspired in a design used by Nick and Nora Jones, the main characters from the 1930s popular film series, "The Thin Man". These distinct look glasses are now bak to the modern bar scene. Its silhouette, somewhere between a martini and a coupe, avoids spillage when drinking, making them perfect for classic and simple cocktails.

ROCKS / DOF

The Double Old-Fashioned (DOF) is the big brother of the Rocks, and therefore also known as a Double Rocks. With its wide rim and often heavy thick base, is ideal for full-bodied alcoholic drinks and cocktails. The rocks, also known as old-fashioned (upon the famous cocktail with the same name), is the classic choice for serving spirits neat or on the rocks.

HIGHBALL / COLLINS

The Collins takes its name from the Tom Collins cocktail, for which it was designed. This cylindrical glass is similar to the popular Highball, but the two shouldn't be confused. The thinner and taller Collins it's ideal for carbonated drinks, while the shorter and wider Highball it is used to create iced drinks and cocktails.

SPECIALTY COCKTAILS

Specialty cocktail glasses are unique designs with a twist of fun, ideal to serve colourful and kitsch 80s' style cocktails and mocktails, with its flamboyant garnishes. Hawaiian style shapes like the Hurricane, Napoli Grande or Bamboo have helped to popularize cocktails such as the Blue Lagoon, Tequila Sunset, or Dark & Stormy.

LIQUOR COFFEE

Liquor coffee is a caffeinated alcoholic drink that consists of a shot of liqueur, mixed with coffee and sweetened with sugar. Typically served in a stemmed glass mug, it is topped with whipped cream for a dramatic appearance. The most popular liquor coffee beverages are the Irish Coffee, The French Connection or the South African Kula.

AMERICANO STYLE

Traditionally served in large mugs, Caffè Americano, also known as Black Coffee, consists of drip-filtered coffee or by pouring hot water over an espresso shot. In the Land Down Under, however, it is served the other way around, an espresso shot is poured over hot water, and it is named an Australian Long Black instead.

CAPPUCCINO

Cappuccino is an Italian classic made with equal parts of espresso, steamed milk and foam, served in small cups, between 18 and 22cl. The size of the cup is important to get the right flavour balance, between the espresso and milk. These cups can accommodate other warm beverages, such as Lungo coffee, Breve, Mocha or even Affogato (espresso with ice cream).

ESPRESSO & CO.

With its typical creaminess and intense flavour, Italian espresso has become the preferred coffee drink worldwide. Served in small capacity cups or tumblers, not more than 12cl, this popular warm beverage is enjoyed in lots of variants, from the very short Ristretto to the double shot Doppio, or in original serves, like Cortado (with warm milk), Romano (with lemon), Vienna (with whipped cream), Café Bombón (with condensed milk) or Espression (with chocolate hazelnut cream).

LATTE VARIATIONS

For those who love sweet coffee based drinks, one of the most popular choices is a flavoured Latte. Served in short glasses with a capacity around 2ocl, these beverages consist in adding milk to coffee and are, usually, topped with foam or cream. Adding a splash of syrup, infusions, spices or rich flavoured ingredients, such as vanilla or caramel, latte comes in lots of variants. Traditional Latte, Flat White and Café au Lait are prepared with steamed milk, while Latte Macchiato and Galão use foamed milk.

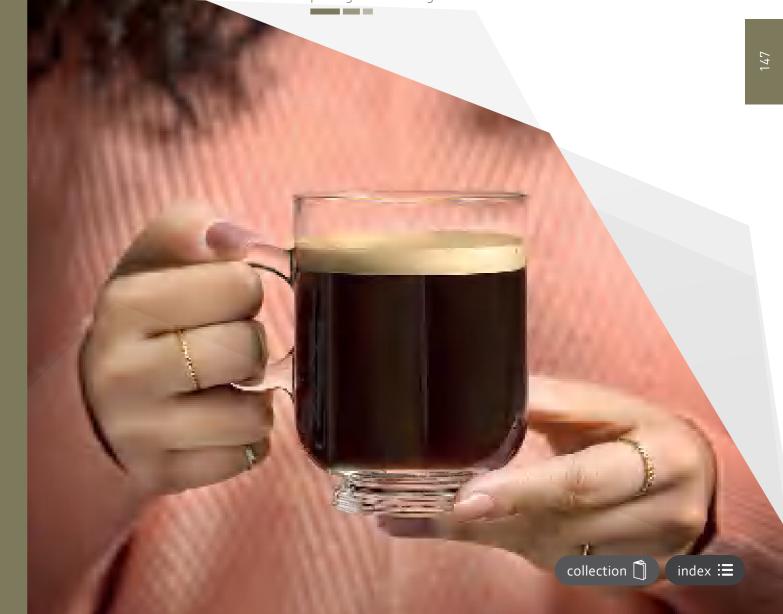

Traditionally, porcelain has been the preferred choice when serving warm beverages, but glassware is being adopted more often in specialized venues, especially for new varieties and methods of preparation. New types of coffee, tea or chocolate-based drinks (latte macchiato, mochaccino, frappuccino, bubble tea or cold brew coffee and tea), open new opportunities for glassware to shine. Baristas tend to prefer the transparency of glass to enhance their presentations, as some of these drinks are so beautifully that it is almost a sin not to serve them in a lovely glass.

Safety tip: always pre-heat glasses with hot water when pouring warm beverages.

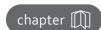

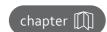
